
Fees

The tuition for the January 2010 three-week studio intensive including studio, staff instruction, visiting artists, room and board (private room with shared bath in the Wyly House dormitory) is \$2950; a room with private bath costs an additional \$250. For those not requesting room and board, the tuition is \$1800. Students can expect to incur additional costs for materials used in the studios. In addition, there is a \$45 registration fee upon acceptance to the program.

A deposit of \$500 is due upon acceptance on November 6 and the full balance is due on November 20, 2009.

Accommodations

The Wyly House dormitory is a two-story coed building located on the Anderson Ranch campus consisting of 18 bedrooms and a common area. There are coin-operated washers and dryers. Phones are not available in the rooms, but there are two pay phones in the lobby. Tuition includes a private room with a shared bath. There are a limited number of private rooms with private baths available for an additional fee of \$250.

Please indicate your choice of accommodations:

- Private room with a shared bath (included in cost of tuition)
- Private room with private bath (for an additional fee of \$250)
- Will not require Anderson Ranch provided housing (opt-out)

Please note: The state of Colorado and Pitkin County require us to charge 10.4% sales tax on lodging. In addition, the Town of Snowmass Village assesses a 2.4% lodging tax on all housing arranged through Anderson Ranch. Therefore, a total accommodation tax of 12.8% will be added to your housing invoice.

Cancellation Policy

In order to receive a refund, cancellation notice must be given by November 30, 2009. Given the required notice, you will be refunded your deposit less the registration fee (\$45) and a cancellation fee of \$300. No refunds will be issued for cancellations made after November 30, 2009.

Anderson Ranch 2010 January Studio Intensive Application Guidelines

Applications must be postmarked by October 26, 2009. Applicants will be notified of their status by November 6, 2009. Information on the progress of an application will not be given before the final decisions are announced. Applicants will be accepted on a space-available basis thereafter.

Open to all forms of visual arts; however, our facilities may limit certain applicants. If your work requires special equipment, please be advised that you will have to provide it yourself. Please feel free to call us if you have any questions.

Please send ten digital images (jpeg only) of your work. Slides will not be accepted. Digital images should be on a CD. Each image should be no more than 1024 pixels in either direction at 72 DPI. Please name each file with your last name, first name initial, underscore, order number (for example, SmithM_1.jpg). Also include an image inventory sheet with corresponding numbers, title, date, medium and dimensions. For time-based work, please send three (3) minutes of a Quicktime video. Please be sure to label the DVD with your name and title (if any) of the work. Only the first three minutes of any video will be reviewed. It may include multiple works. Submitted CDs/DVDs will not be returned. Please DO NOT send show announcements, catalogues, reviews or letters of recommendation; they will not be reviewed or returned.
