### ARTISTS-IN-RESIDENCE PROGRAM

Artists are encouraged to pursue their own work as part of a community of artistic peers. The residency allows artists to take risks and pursue new projects and ideas, or develop existing ones, free from everyday pressures. Residencies are offered to artists working in one of the following media:

- Ceramics
- Photography and New Media
- Furniture Design and Woodworking
- Painting and Drawing
- Printmaking
- Sculpture

Housing, studio space, meals are provided for a fee of \$1500, as well as opportunities for professional critiques during the 10-week session. Upon acceptance, four residents are awarded paid fellowships by the jury panel based on merit of their work. ### PROGRAM DATES

Residencies are offered two terms each year.

**TERM I – Fall:** October – December (10 weeks)

**TERM II – Spring:** February – April (10 weeks)

## APPLICATION/SELECTION PROCESS

Applications for both terms must be submitted online by **FEBRUARY 15** of each year. To apply, please visit: [andersonranch.slideroom.com](http://andersonranch.slideroom.com).

A jury of established artists, critics and curators ranks the applications based on the merit of the artwork submitted.

The Ranch strives to create a community of Artists-in-Residence that reflects a rich mix of artistic diversity.



## QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicants must be practicing artists capable of working in a self-directed capacity.
- The application is open to any artist over the age of 21.
- Approximately 14 artists will be in residence during each term.

## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Ten images of recent work or up to two minutes of time-based work
- Statement of purpose / project proposal
- Resume or CV and a written bio in 40 words or less
- Three references
- Application fee of \$60
