Our studios are open 24 hours Monday - Friday and participants are encouraged to continue their work on weekday evenings.

We encourage students to join their faculty and class for the Sunday welcome dinner at 6 pm as well as faculty presentations at 7 pm on Sunday and Tuesday evenings. Students should plan to attend our Monday morning orientation at 8:45 am in Schermer Meeting Hall. Other events may include the Featured Artists Lecture Series and Friday auctionettes.

Your studio fee will provide the following: various paper, cotton rags, solvents, easels, scissors, pushpins, masking tapes, hand tools, rulers, clamps, staple guns, projector, computer use, and studio maintenance & cleaning. Gamsol is the only solvent allowed in the painting studio. Please do not bring encaustic materials unless the workshop is encaustic. Please do not bring cobalt driers, spray paints, or alcohol-based products. The store at Anderson Ranch has a great selection of art supplies. We may not carry all supplies on your list. If you purchase your class supplies ahead of time through The ArtWorks Store we offer a 10% discount. For questions or to place an order, please contact info@andersonranch.org or 970-923-3181.

Keep in mind that Anderson Ranch is located in a remote mountain town. <u>Some equipment and materials will be difficult to find locally. Please plan accordingly and **order your supplies before the workshop start date.** Each workshop has its own requirements and dynamics that may necessitate changes in this overview. Please bring the following tools and supplies to your workshop available in The ArtWorks Store:

OIL PAINT, 40 ml tubes in the following colors:

- Titanium White, Cadmium Red Medium, Quinacridone Red or Alizarin Crimson Cadmium Yellow (light or medium), Yellow Ochre, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, Raw Umber, Viridian Optional: Chromium Oxide Green, Naples Yellow, Cerulean, Cobalt or Manganese Blue; Dioxazine Purple; other colors you are interested in.

BRUSHES Natural Bristle/Hog Hair

- One 4" wide flat chip brush, cheap house paint brush from hardware store, short handle
- Assortment of 7-8 brushes, ranging in size from 1/4" to 2" wide. "Brights", with short bristles, or "Flats", with longer bristles preferred. "Filberts", with rounded tips, will also work. Sizes vary by brush manufacturer so it's best to select by width.
- Bring at least one each of the following widths in "Bright" brushes: 1/4", 1/2", 3/4", 1", 1 1/2". Optional: You may also want to bring round and fan brushes if you already have them.

SUPPORTS

- Unstretched, primed canvas to staple to the studio wall, and/or stretched canvases or panels. Recommendations: 53" x 3-6 yard canvas roll (allows you to work on a larger scale) and/or 5 stretched canvases/panels, both square and rectangular, minimum 18" x 18" square.

SUPPLIES/TOOLS

- One HB and one 2B graphite pencil
- Colored pencils, set of 12, Prismacolor recommended
- Charcoal, soft compressed, 2 sticks
- Small Kneaded eraser

- 3-5 sheets of 22" x 30" 250gsm drawing paper, Rives BFK recommended
- Disposable Palette Pad, white, 12" x 16", no thumb hole
- Palette Knife, Style 96 RGM recommended 3/4" wide at base by 4 1/4" long

Please bring the following tools and supplies to your workshop <u>not available</u> in The ArtWorks Store:

- Phone, tablet, or laptop to access personal photos, media and art historical images

In preparation for your workshop, please plan for packing materials that you want to use to ship your project home, like moving blankets, packing tape, bubble wrap or cardboard boxes.
